

Food Service rebate incentives and conditions

For a limited time, earn a 50% bonus for rebates when completing food service retrofits. Upgrades must be completed and submitted for payment by November 15, 2021.

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Additional requirements

1. Rebates are available for NEW commercial equipment only. Used or refurbished equipment does not apply.
2. Incentive is for adding variable speed fan controls to the exhaust fan motor serving the kitchen vent hoods, usually accomplished by adding a variable frequency drive (VFD) to the motor with temperature and/or grease sensors to determine the needed exhaust fan speed. Additionally, the makeup air unit (MAU) supply fan speed may need to be interlocked to be controlled as well. The incentive is the same whether or not the MAU is controlled, but the energy savings will be higher if the MAU is controlled as well. Incentive is per controlled horsepower. So, instead of entering the number of controlled fans/motors, enter the total controlled horsepower.

Limited time 50% bonus incentive details and requirements:

Starting June 1, 2021 Efficiency Works Business is offering a 50% bonus on rebates for efficiency upgrades in the following categories: Food Service, Grocery, Office and appliance, Building envelope, Cooling, VFDs and Water retrofits. To qualify for the bonus efficiency retrofit incentives, upgrades must be completed and submitted for payment by November 15, 2021.

- Qualifying rebate categories: Food Service, Grocery, Office and appliance, Building envelope, Cooling, VFDs and Water retrofits
- Electric efficiency incentives are available to commercial electric customers of Estes Park Power and Communications, Fort Collins Utilities, Longmont Power & Communications or Loveland Water and Power
- Water efficiency incentives are available to commercial water customers of Fort Collins Utilities, City of Longmont or Loveland Water and Power
- Bonus does NOT apply to lighting retrofits, custom upgrades, new construction projects, or building tune-up incentives
- Efficiency projects started after June 1, 2021 are eligible based on a rebate pre-approval date or the date listed on the contract (invoice) if the project did not require preapproval
- Total incentive amounts over \$10,000 require pre-approval before efficiency upgrades begin
- Upgrades must be completed and submitted for payment on or before November 15, 2021
- Total incentives are limited to 100% of a project total upgrade cost
- Efficiency Works Business maximum incentive limits will apply per project and customer per calendar year
